

SAFETY AND SECURITY

- * Wear comfortable clothing and according to the weather.
- * Walk carefully over slippery, wet surfaces, stairs, ramps, ... Use handrails or lean on the walls if necessary.
- * Do not run, jump, push somebody. Respect the safety distance, do not go beyond the safety barriers, and do not get close to the well.
- * Respect the furniture and exhibits.
- * Pay attention to the glass doors, low lintels and other elements at head height.
- * In the parapet and roof, it is recommended to walk in single file and carefully, leaning against walls and rails, never project the body onto the railing or the battlements.

EuroEume

Located in the Moeche Valley, in Saint George hamlet (San Xurxo de Moeche), this 14th century castle defies the time and invites us to recreate episodes of history it witnessed: the social riot known as “Revoltas Irmandiñas”, the fight and alliances amongst feudal lords, the dawn of the feudal system, ...

Destroyed during the “Revoltas Irmandiñas”, it was rebuilt by the same peasants who had demolished it in reaction to the feudal lord’s cruelty, during the 15th century. Thanks to the last restoration, we can see the remains of the old castle highlighted on the floor with a different pavement.

The fortress, partially protected by a moat, is divided in 7 areas with a wide range of medioeval architecture features, some of them just seen in this castle.

Going into the castle through the main gate allows the visitor to contemplate the barbican, the arrow loops, and coats of arms in the keep’s walls.

Once inside the tower, a touchscreen and panels give us an overview over the cultural park known as “ETP Eume-Xuvia”, which embraces the main cultural attractions in the area.

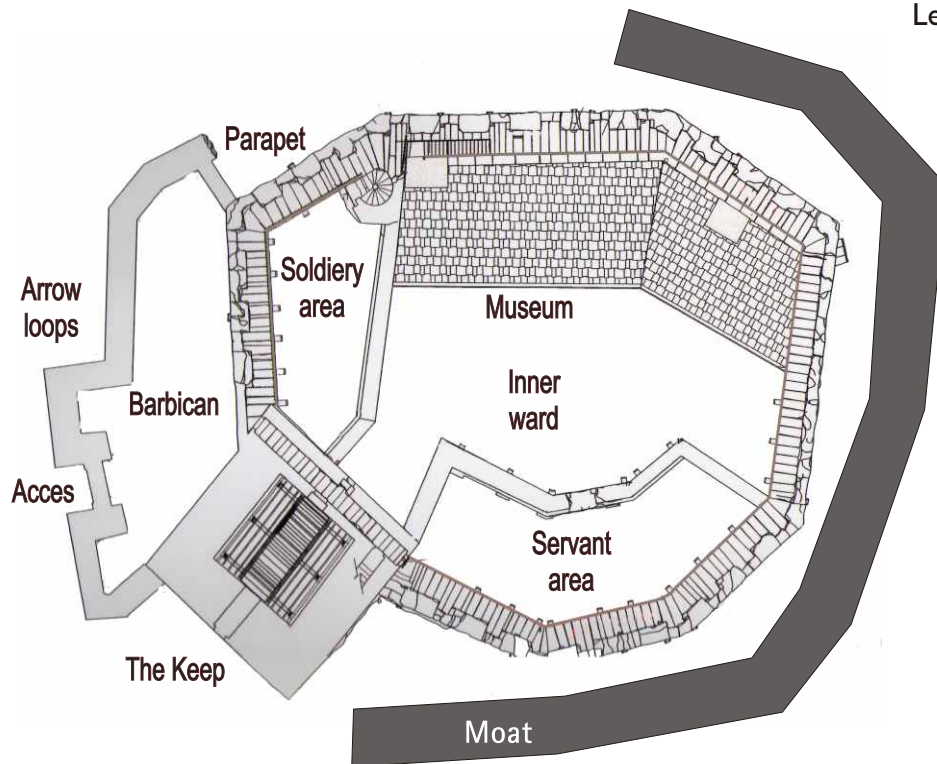

Leaving behind the barbican, visitors go into the remaining castle’s Areas: the keep, the servants area, the soldiery area and the museum.

A remarkable element is the crenallated parapet which surrounds the fortress and provides a breathtaking panoramic view to the valley. The crenallated parapet, facilitates the access to the keep and plays an important role in the castle defence.
